Opt out procedure

Enrollment in the plan is automatic. During the opt out and modification period, you can withdraw from the plan directly on our website. You must withdraw at the beginning of each academic year. Please note that it is impossible to withdraw yourself partially from the plan.

If you choose to opt out, Major Plan will reimburse your plan enrollment fees within two weeks of the withdrawal period.
